Establishes the boiler and elevator special fund to collect and deposit fees for inspections, permits, and examinations of boilers, pressure systems, elevators, and kindred equipment; provides for sufficient operating costs to carry out the purpose of the boiler and elevator safety law. Authorizes the director of labor and industrial relations to establish up to ten additional positions, including elevator and boiler inspectors. Appropriates funds for start up costs and hiring of necessary staff.

SB 2068 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Prohibits strikes by public employees who are designated as essential employees.	JDL, WAM
