(HSCR563-12) Status

Establishes unlicensed contracting activity as a misdemeanor offense; establishes habitual unlicensed contracting activity and unlicensed contractor fraud as felonies. Requires that each day of unlicensed contracting activity be deemed a separate offense. Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1295 HD2)
