SB 2424, SD2 (SSCR2794) Status RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYER ORGANIZATIONS. Adds powers and duties to the director of labor and industrial relations regarding the registration and regulation of professional employer organizations. Authorizes various penalties for noncompliance; amends definitions and bond level requirements; establishes the professional employer organization special fund. Repeals chapter 373K, HRS, but moves the general excise tax exemption provisions to chapter 373L, HRS. Appropriates funds to the department of labor and industrial relations. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)
