penalty.

RELATING TO TAXATION.

TOU, FIN

FIN

Status Requires that all advertisements and solicitations for transient

accommodations conspicuously display the registration identification

number. Applies beginning 1/1/13.

HB 1760

RELATING TO TIME SHARE ZONING.

TOU, WLO, JUD

Status

Authorizes the counties to restrict time share units and time share plans in zoning districts, other than time share zoning districts, including

areas designated for hotel use, resort use, or transient vacation rentals.

HB 2673

RELATING TO TOURISM.

TOU, WLO, FIN

Status

Provides individuals occupying transient accommodations with the ability to donate \$1 to the Department of Land and Natural Resources

for the State Park System. Authorizes acceptance of donations into the

State Parks Special Fund.
