Ms. Kaulukukui studied at the University of Hawai'i's Environmental Center and earned a Juris Doctorate and a Certificate in Environmental Law from the William S. Richardson School of Law at the University of Hawai'i. She has also worked with the state Department of Land and Natural Resources, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, and the non-profit environmental law firm Earthjustice.

She currently works as a land management specialist with OHA, and in her previous position as an OHA Policy Advocate, she conducted numerous compliance reviews of Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 343 Environmental Assessments and Environmental Impact Statements.

Ms. Kaulukukui also donates her time to serve on the boards of two local non-profit organizations dedicated to the natural and cultural resources of Hawai'i, and she sits on the state Forest Stewardship Advisory Committee.
