Subject: House Bill No. 1768 Relating to the Hawaii Public Procurement Code

The City & County of Honolulu supports H.B. 1768 which provides clarification that if an award is determined to be in violation of the law and the contract has not been fully executed that the award may be rescinded and remedies prior to award may be applied, which may include the reevaluation and award of the contract to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder or responsible offeror.

The proposed revision to HRS §103D-707 will provide an additional post-award remedy. Currently, the only available remedies are ratification of the contract or termination of the contract. The remedy to award to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder or responsible offeror will reduce the administrative burdens of a resolicitation, avoid the damaging delays to economic revitalization that are inherent in a re-solicitation effort, and will promote fairness to bidders or offerors who submitted proposals in good faith.
