House Bill 2540 would allow the Department of Human Services to charge reasonable fees to obtain a child care license or certificate of registration and establishes a special fund.

HAEYC supports the intent of this measure but would request that the purpose of the fees be defined in such a way as to ensure that they go toward furthering the provision of quality child care services and we would request that it be a nominal fee
