Dear Senator Ige:

The Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO strongly supports the purpose and intent of H.B. 492, H.D. 2, S.D. 1 which corrects some of the operational deficiencies identified by the Auditor in Report 10-06, Audit of the Department of Public Safety, Sheriff Division, issued in June 2010. The Auditor found that the Sheriff Division has been assigned a range of duties, but because of "ineffective leadership" at the departmental level, the state law enforcement agency "lacks guidance and direction."

We agree with the Auditor that since the Sheriff Division was transferred to the Department of Public Safety in 1989, it has had an ill-defined role and a lack of clarity about its mission. As a result, the Sheriff Division has struggled to uphold its expanded law enforcement duties and responsibilities. H.B. 492, H.D. 2, S.D. 1 specifies corrective action to improve deficiencies highlighted in the audit through a report to the 2012 Legislature on such issues as follows:

- 1. Improving the division's radio system to provide adequate and reliable communications for on-duty officers in line with the applicable law enforcement standards of the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies. This is safety issue for our members.
- 2. Relocating the receiving desk from Halawa Correctional Facility to address the problem of processing a defendant in one location and retrieving warrants from a distant location, and to facilitate the process that applies to persons who turn themselves in voluntarily.
- 3. Addressing departmental leadership concerns by developing and implementing internal controls to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of Sheriff Division operations that meet its division's goals and objectives.

4. Requiring the Departments of Transportation and Public Safety to remedy problems in the Auditor's Report related to airport security.
