Mission Statement

To re-establish agriculture as essential to the well-being of our island society by rejuvenating the economy, protecting important resources, and gaining greater self-sufficiency in food production and alternative energy development.

Context

The Department of Agriculture has many varied responsibilities including establishing and maintaining irrigation systems, managing agricultural lands, marketing and business development, preventing the entry of invasive species into the state, pest and disease control and eradication, maintaining healthy livestock industries, rabies prevention, and food safety and quality assurance programs.

Departmental programs continue to closely monitor expenditures for items such as travel, utilities, fuel and supplies. Programs are encouraged to take the necessary steps to conserve energy such as limiting the use of air conditioning and turning off lights and equipment while not in use. Equipment, motor vehicle replacement, and repair and maintenance of facilities are being deferred but must be balanced with employees being able to perform their duties, and consideration for employee and public safety. When allowed in appropriate agreements, federal funds are used to replace equipment and motor vehicles.

Although the economic condition of the past few years has affected the department deeply, available resources are being utilized to move forward and aid the agriculture and aquaculture industries in becoming an integral part of the State's economic recovery.

Programs do not face a “funding cliff” due to loss of ARRA funds however it is anticipated that funding for nine Plant Quarantine Inspector positions at the Kahului Airport that was provided by the Federal Aviation Administration through the State Department of Transportation will be discontinued. Alternative funding for these positions will be utilized to continue the current level of inspection services at the airport.

Alternatives Considered

Generating Additional Revenue for the State

The majority of departmental programs are either partially or fully funded by non-general funds. In addition, departmental programs generated approximately \$948,000 for the general fund through licenses, fees and fines in FY 11. Departmental programs actively pursue federal funds through applying for grants and entering into cooperative agreements. In order to leverage state funds, important federal partnerships with various US Department of Agriculture agencies such as the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Rural Development program, Farm Service Agency, Natural Resource Conservation Service, Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education program and the Department of Interior- Bureau of Reclamation will continue to be fostered. Relationships with state organizations such as UH-CTHAR, UH-Cooperative Extension Services, UH-Sea Grant College and the RCUH will also be sustained.

Shifting General Funded Operations to Non-General Funds

In recent years nearly sixty positions have been shifted from general to non-general funds. The majority of these changes have involved placing Plant Quarantine Inspector positions on to the Pest Inspection, Quarantine and Eradication special fund. The supplemental budget request includes the establishment of special fund positions that were previously general funded and the deletion of the general fund supplement to the Irrigation Systems Revolving fund. Further shift of personnel and other operating costs from general to non-general funds are limited by the revenues coming into these special funds and the allowable uses of the funds.

Consolidation or Elimination of Programs Within the Department

Due to reductions in personnel the Aquaculture Development Program has been integrated into the Animal Industry Division to allow for efficient utilization of staff. This consolidated program will support the development of all commercial livestock industries (aquaculture, cattle, dairy, egg, poultry, swine) in Hawaii. The program’s goal is to develop sustainable and successful industry segments that can effectively adapt to changing economic conditions.

Reduction of Services

Reductions in the general fund budget allow the department to only carry out the highest priority functions. Every attempt has been made to minimize the impact on the industry and the general public but due to the severity of past budget cuts and lay-offs, slow-downs in service and discontinuation of certain functions have been unavoidable.

Recent filling of positions has addressed some staffing shortfalls. The filling of Plant Quarantine Inspector positions has allowed for an increase in staff during each shift and a slight increase in inspection hours. Other programs have begun to fill key positions and service to the industry and general public will continue to improve.
