RE: SB2494 Proposed SD1; Relating to Animal Cruelty- Dog Breeders

Dear Honorable Chair Hee, Vice Chair Shimabukuro and Committee Members,

The Hawaiian Humane Society supports the intent of SB 2494 SD 1 and specifically the regulation of number of dogs a large-scale breeder may possess as well as the minimum standards of care. We are, however, concerned with certain language in the proposed bill as well and the feasibility of carrying out proposed tasks:

- Although the Hawaiian Humane Society currently has the City and County of Honolulu animal control contract and currently investigates animal cruelty cases and violations, it is not equipped administratively to handle the licensing of dog breeders and imposing penalties upon violation of such licensing.
- Also, there has not been an increase in any funding on our City and County contract for animal control and the Society would not be able to administer licensing without further funding.
- We strongly support the passage of SB2492, where the Hawaiian Humane Society
 would have access to and be able to inspect breeding facilities to note cases of
 cruelty/ standards of care not being met; but will not be given the duty of licensing
 breeders or citing breeders for violation of missing records or clerical paperwork.

I oppose this legislation, here's why:

I know it's been a few years since I had occasion to look at the amendments to the US constitution, but did we lose 4 and 14 somewhere, or are we just going to ignore <u>probable cause</u> and <u>due process</u>?

Did someone rewrite Merriam Webster's dictionary, to redefine <u>dog breeder</u> to mean any one who owned 10 adult, intact dogs?

While I abhor animal cruelty of any stripe, I find this piece of legislation to be equally abhorrent. It should be deferred, resisted, and duly processed in the nearest shredder.

And who died and put the legislature in charge of determining who should make judgments about what animals, if any, should be bred?

It might be more 'profitable' to put teeth into the current animal cruelty laws, instead of confusing the identity of occasional hobby breeders with the former Waimanalo puppy mill operation.

The ILIO magazine publishes guidelines for responsible breeders that outline prudent, practical, responsible practices for breeders and puppy buyers.

The auditors report last year recommended alternatives to licensing breeders given lack of information on how much licensing and cost of monitoring would be.

While you may not like the sarcastic tone of this testimony, I suggest we have far greater concerns and major challenges to our economy, environment, and the freedoms we take for granted, that need your attention.
