Voters in the 2010 General Election approved a constitutional amendment calling for an appointed, rather than elected, Board of Education. SB8 seeks to establish a process by which the Board will be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the State Senate. The proposed legislation creates an eleven-member Board, including a voting student member, and defines broad parameters that the Senate shall consider when confirming appointees.
