- 2) **Repair roofing at 'Iolani Palace, Kanaina Building, and the Barracks;**
- 3) **Repair various areas damaged by termites;**
- 4) **Upgrade electrical wiring and network cabling;**
- 5) **Repair or replace window shutters at the Barracks;**
- 6) **Repair various historic doors and related hardware;**
- 7) **Upgrade security equipment in various locations;**
- 8) **Refinish window shutters at 'Iolani Palace;**
- 9) **Repair and repaint iron staircases (mauka and makai) of 'Iolani Palace;**
- 10) **Repaint exterior façade of Kanaina Building.**

Design and construction involving historic structures are reviewed by a historic preservation architect as well as the State Historic Preservation Division.**
