# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVATE GUARDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 463-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3           "(a) Effective July 1, [~~2013,~~] 2014, all guards, and all  
4 agents, operatives, and assistants employed by a guard agency,  
5 private business entity, or government agency who act in a guard  
6 capacity shall apply to register with the board, and meet the  
7 following registration, instruction, and training requirements  
8 prior to acting as a guard:

- 9           (1) Be not less than eighteen years of age;
- 10           (2) Possess a high school education or its equivalent;
- 11           (3) Not be presently suffering from any psychiatric or  
12 psychological disorder which is directly related and  
13 detrimental to a person's performance in the  
14 profession; and
- 15           (4) Not have been convicted in any jurisdiction of a crime  
16 which reflects unfavorably on the fitness of the  
17 individual to act as a guard, unless the conviction  
18 has been annulled or expunged by court order; provided
