The purpose of this measure is to help ensure that the members of the University of Hawaii Board of Regents complement each other's strengths to form a well-rounded and cohesive body by authorizing the Governor to reject the list of candidates presented by the Regents Candidate Advisory Council and require the Council to present the Governor with a new list within sixty days of the rejection.

The Regents Candidate Advisory Council provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Removing the authorization for the Governor to reject the list of candidates;
- (2) Inserting an authorization for the Governor to request additional candidates from the Council;
- (3) Increasing to 90 from 60 the number of days the Council has to comply with the Governor's request for additional candidates; and

(4) Making technical, nonsubstantivé amendments for clarity and consistency.
