County of Honolulu Emergency Services Department, Visitor Aloha
Society of Hawaii, North Shore Lifeguard Association, Hawaiian
Lifeguard Association, Kauaii Fire Department, Ocean Safety
Windward, East Hawaii Ocean Safety, Big Island Lifeguard
Association, Kauai Lifeguard Association, and numerous concerned
individuals supported this measure. The Department of Public
Safety supported the intent of this measure. A few concerned
individuals opposed this measure. The Department of Budget and
Finance provided comments.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- Changing the name of the new unit from "first responders including state law enforcement officers and state and county ocean safety and water safety officers "to "state law enforcement officers and state and county ocean safety and water safety officers" for clarity; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style, clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Labor & Public Employment and Public Safety that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1172, as amended herein, and recommend that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1172, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
