## Madam:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to establish, within the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Hawaii Agriculture Workforce Advisory Board.

The purpose of the Board is to:

- Develop the next generation of the agriculture workforce (1)in the State;
- Develop partnerships with agricultural organizations and stakeholders:
- (3) Maintain and support the National Future Farmers of America Organization within the State; and
- Recommend projects and programs to promote the expansion and development of the agricultural industry in the State.

This measure also appropriates an unspecified sum of funds to assist in the establishment and support of the Hawaii Agriculture Workforce Advisory Board.

Your Committee received written comments in support of this measure from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations and two individuals.

Your Committee finds that this measure will further the policy of the State, as expressed by the State Planning Act, to promote economically competitive activities that increase Hawaii's agricultural self-sufficiency and to increase the attractiveness and opportunities for an agricultural education and livelihood.
