Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 81 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND TO PAY THE TRICARE RESERVE SELECT PREMIUM FOR ELIGIBLE STATE AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVES WHO DECLINE HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE THROUGH THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND AND INSTEAD OPT FOR HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE THROUGH TRICARE RESERVE SELECT,"

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Board of Trustees of the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund to pay the TRICARE Reserve Select premium for eligible state and county employees who:

- (1) Are members of the National Guard and Reserves; and
- (2) Decline health insurance coverage through the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund and instead opt for health insurance coverage through the federallyadministered TRICARE Reserve Select.

The State Representative of the Thirty-Third Representative District supported this measure. The Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund Board of Trustees opposed this measure.
