Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 1094, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to recapitalize the emergency and budget reserve fund.

More specifically, this measure appropriates an unspecified amount from general funds to the emergency and budget reserve fund for fiscal year 2014-2015.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of the Governor, Department of Budget and Finance, Catholic Charities Hawaii, and one individual.

Your Committee recognizes that the use of moneys from the emergency and budget reserve fund and the Hawaii hurricane relief fund during the economic recession beginning in 2008 allowed the State to avoid having to take even greater spending reductions and revenue enhancement measures and enabled continued delivery of services to the State's most vulnerable populations. Now that the State's economy is rebounding and more resources are available, a concerted effort must be made to recapitalize the State's depleted fiscal reserves. Accordingly, your Committee finds that this

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measure is essential to safeguard the future economic well-being of the State.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Changing the effective date to July 1, 2030, to facilitate further discussion; and
