Your Committees on Tourism and Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 170, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TOURISM,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to expand the powers and duties of the Hawaii Tourism Authority to include perpetuating the uniqueness of the native Hawaiian culture and community that is important to the quality of the visitor experience in Hawaii. Specifically, this measure requires the Hawaii Tourism Authority to ensure that:

- Native Hawaiian culture is accurately portrayed by Hawaii's visitor industry;
- (2) The Hawaiian language is supported and normalized as an official language of the State and as the foundation of the host culture;
- (3) Native Hawaiian cultural practitioners and cultural sites that give value to Hawaii's heritage are supported, nurtured, and engaged in sustaining the visitor industry; and

(4) A native Hawaiian cultural education and training program is provided for the visitor industry workforce having direct contact with visitors.

The Hawaii Tourism Authority and a concerned individual supported this measure. The Department of Transportation supported the intent of this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by making it effective upon its approval.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Tourism and Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
