The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge Hawaii's

appropriations honoring the late Senator Daniel K. Inouye and late
Representative Patsy T. Mink through public works of art.

the legacy and contributions of the late Senator Inouye and late
Representative Mink will perpetuate their legacies and inspire
future generations. Urging Hawaii's congressional delegation to
procure matching federal funds will help fund the expected high
cost of commissioning the works of art, including the creation of
permanent sculptures.

Committee on Ways and Means that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 10,
S.D. 1, and recommends its adoption.
