Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 29, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO CHOOSE A LOCATION FOR, BUILD, AND OPERATE AN INFORMATIONAL KIOSK FOR THE PUBLIC IN THE HAWAII CAPITAL HISTORIC DISTRICT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the Department of Accounting and General Services to convene a working group to choose a location for, build, and operate an informational kiosk for the public in the Hawaii Capital Historic District.

Your Committee received written comments in opposition to this measure from the Hawaii Tourism Authority. The Department of Accounting and General Services submitted written comments.

Your Committee finds that the Hawaii Capital Historic District contains an array of unique historic sites, each pivotal to the social and political legacy of the State. These historic sites, including Iolani Palace, the State Capitol Building, and the Kamehameha Statue, are important visitor destinations for tourists and residents alike. However, your Committee also finds that, due to funding constraints and advertisement costs, many of the nonprofit foundations that support these historic sites cannot afford sufficient publicity for their exhibits and presentations.
