SB 1020, SD1 (SSCR462) Status

RELATING TO CHARITABLE SOLICITATION.

CPC

Extends reporting and recordkeeping requirements to commercial coventurers; allows penalties to be imposed on commercial co-venturers who fail to comply with reporting requirements; clarifies the

exemption from registration for organizations who receive less than

\$25,000 in contributions annually. (SD1)

RELATING TO PHYSICAL THERAPY.

HLT, CPC

Amends chapter 461J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by mandating that physical therapists practicing in the State of Hawaii shall submit

evidence of continuing competence at each renewal period.

SB 400, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1164) Status

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

HUS, CPC

Requires child care facilities that care for children younger than one or younger to implement and maintain safe sleep policies to prevent sudden unexpected infant deaths and sudden infant death syndrome in accordance with rules adopted by the Department of Human Services.

SB 423 (HSCR1045) Status	RELATING TO IN VITRO FERTILIZATION INSURANCE COVERAGE. Amends references to the "American College of Obstetric and Gynecology" to "American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists".	HLT, CPC
SB 1073, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1211) Status	RELATING TO DENTAL SERVICE CORPORATIONS. Establishes licensing and financial solvency requirements for dental service corporations and repeals chapters 423 and 448D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, containing superseded provisions. Effective July 1, 2112. (SB1073 HD1)	HLT, CPC
SB 470, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1120) Status	RELATING TO CREDIT CARDS. Prohibits retailers from imposing credit card surcharges in certain instances on cardholders electing to make payment by credit card. Effective January 20, 2050. (SB470 HD1)	EDB, CPC
SB 682, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1192) Status	RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION. Clarifies the authority of the county fire chiefs to examine building plans and documentation to ensure that they are in compliance with the county's adopted fire code. Requires the issuance of permits before work may begin. Effective July 1, 2013. (SB682 HD1)	PBS, CPC
SB 482, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1064) Status	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Clarifies the maximum number of gallons of honey that can be sold by a certified honey house or food processing establishment without obtaining a permit from the Department of Health. Exempts from the permit requirement sales of honey directly to retail stores that in turn sell the honey directly to consumers. Requires honey producers to include certain wording on labels of each container of honey, take a food safety class, and make records available to the Department of Health. Exempts the State and counties from liability. (SB482 HD1)	AGR, CPC
SB 319, HD1 (HSCR1036) Status	RELATING TO THRILL CRAFT. Allows thrill craft to be used to conduct ocean cleanup activities. Requires the Department of Land and Natural Resources to adopt rules to implement such use of thrill craft. (SB319 HD1)	EEP/OMH, CPC
SB 15, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1181) Status	RELATING TO ENERGY. Establishes a task force to examine changing the 10 percent ethanol requirement for gasoline to a locally-produced biofuels and biodiesel requirement. Establishes Biofuels Production Income Tax Credit. Repeals Ethanol Facility Tax Credit. (SB15 HD1)	EEP, CPC
SB 987, SD1 (HSCR1155) Status	RELATING TO IMPACT FEES. Requires the assessment of impact fees prior to issuance of a water meter and requires that impact fees be collected in full before or upon issuance of the water meter. Effective 07/01/50. (SD1)	WAL, CPC
SB 19, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1184) Status	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Exempts landlords and lessors who install renewable energy systems on their property and provide, sell, or transmit the power generated therefrom to electric utilities and tenants or lessees on the same property from the definition of "public utility". (SB19 HD1)	EEP, CPC

SB 1040 (HSCR1132) Status

RELATING TO ELECTRIC SYSTEMS.

EEP, CPC

Authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to consider the value of implementing advanced grid modernization technology in the State.

SB 1045, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1182) Status

RELATING TO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES.

EEP, CPC

Authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to waive or exempt an electric cooperative operating in the State from compliance with the provisions of chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as well as any other applicable charters, franchises, rules, decisions, orders, or any

other laws. (SB1045 HD1)

SB 120, SD1 (HSCR1041) **Status**

RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES.

EEP, CPC

Authorizes the public utilities commission to establish a policy to implement economic incentives and cost recovery regulatory mechanisms to induce and accelerate electric utilities' cost reduction efforts, encourage greater utilization of renewable energy, accelerate the retirement of utility fossil generation, and increase investments to modernize the State's electrical grids. (SD1)

SB 1079 (SSCR246) **Status**

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

CPC

Amends the definition of "small employer" contained in section 431:2-201.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes; amends sections 432:1-102(b) and 432D-19(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes, by including the producer licensing requirements contained in article 9A of chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

SB 548, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1216) Status

RELATING TO TELEMEDICINE.

VMI, HLT, CPC

Exempts from licensing requirement to practice medicine in the State any commissioned medical officer employed by the U.S. Department of Defense, who is credentialed by Tripler Army Medical Center, while providing direct telemedicine support or services to neighbor island beneficiaries within a Hawaii national guard armory on the island of Kauai, Hawaii, Molokai, or Maui. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB548 HD1)

SB 1076 (HSCR1052) Status

RELATING TO THE USE OF THE DOCTOR OF ACUPUNCTURE HLT, CPC

Requires acupuncture applicants for the use of the doctor of acupuncture title to complete their doctoral studies from an institution recognized by the United States acupuncture accrediting body or from a foreign institution that is licensed, approved, or accredited by the applicable governmental authority in that respective foreign jurisdiction and also requires applicants for the use of the doctor of acupuncture title who complete their doctoral studies from a doctoral program at an educational institution in a foreign jurisdiction to have their doctoral education credentials evaluated by professional evaluators designated by the Board of Acupuncture.

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RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL SB 965, SD1, HD1 VMI, CPC (HSCR952) LICENSING. Status Limits licensure by endorsement or reciprocity for military spouses to those spouses who are present in the State for at least one year pursuant to United States Department of Defense orders. (SB965 HD1) RELATING TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS. JUD, CPC SB 858, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1037) Restricts members of boards and commissions whose reappointment to a second consecutive term has failed to receive the consent of the Status senate from serving as a holdover member. (SB858 HD1) SB 512, SD1, HD1 RELATING TO ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS. LAB/EEP, CPC (HSCR1135) Provides a limited exemption to the licensing requirements for certain Status individuals in situations when an electric utility must contract with qualified individuals to work with high voltage (six hundred volts or more), who are not licensed in Hawaii but satisfy specified requirements. Sunsets June 30, 2018. (SB512 HD1) RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS. HSG, CPC SB 507, SD1 (HSCR965) Creates notice requirements for regular annual meetings or special Status meetings of a planned community association. (SD1) SB 1077, SD2, HD1 RELATING TO THE OWNER-BUILDER EXEMPTION. WAL/AGR, CPC (HSCR1060) Sets forth specific responsibilities of and protections for ownerbuilders exempted from contractor licensing and other requirements; **Status** amends the fine schedule to be based on the circumstances of each case. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB1077 HD1) SB 586, SD1, HD1 RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL BUILDING PERMITS. AGR/WAL, CPC (HSCR1144) Provides, under certain circumstances, an exemption from building code and permit requirements for nonresidential buildings or **Status** structures, including indigenous Hawaiian hale, on commercial farms and ranches located outside the urban district. Effective July 1, 2013.
