DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

HB62 SD1 RELATING TO PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGERS. HTH, CPN

(SSCR911) Prohibits a pharmacy benefits manager from using a patient's Status and Testimony prescription drug benefits claim information to market to that

patient the services of a preferred pharmacy network that is owned by the pharmacy benefits manager, except in certain situations.

Effective July 1, 2112. (SD1)

HB398 SD1 RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. HMS/HTH, CPN

(SSCR931) Requires child care facilities, family child care homes, group child care centers, group child care homes, and infant and toddler child

care centers that care for children less than one year of age to develop, maintain, and implement safe sleep policies as adopted by the Department of Human Services, to prevent sudden unexpected infant deaths and sudden infant death syndrome.

Establishes a task force to address issues of home and community-based facilities during the transition of services from the department of human services to the department of health.
