HB 811, HD1 (HSCR241) Status

RELATING TO ENERGY INFORMATION REPORTING. Amends the responsibilities and powers of the Public Utilities Commission in receiving energy industry data information registrations, and authorizes the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to receive such registrations; and eliminates the Commission's powers concerning the oversight and examination of energy distributors in relation to energy industry information reporting under chapter 486J, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Effective July 1, 2013. (HB811 HD1)

HB 560, HD1 (HSCR213) Status RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING URBAN GARDENING. HSG, EDB

Authorizes the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation and Hawaii Community Development Authority to develop programs that provide incentives for the development of housing projects that

HB 567 Status

RELATING TO URBAN GROWTH COMMISSION.

EDB

Establishes an urban growth commission to establish standards for density, building design, and infrastructure, and other standards the commission deems necessary to mitigate adverse impacts of development on the surrounding community, within urban growth boundaries.
