Appropriates funds from the agricultural development and food security special fund to the DOA for the U.S. Pacific Basin

Agricultural Research Center to research and develop methods for the prevention and treatment of coffee berry borer infestations. Provides a grant-in-aid from the agricultural development and food security special fund for the coffee berry borer task force for control of the coffee berry borer and mitigation of damage.

HB 868 RELATING TO ELIMINATING THE ASSET LIMIT ELIGIBILITY. HUS, FIN REQUIREMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR (HSCR27) NEEDY FAMILIES PROGRAM. Status | Eliminates the asset limit for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program. HB 1208, HD1 RELATING TO CERTIFICATION AND LICENSURE FEES.
