RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION.

EEP, HLT

Establishes a separate Water Pollution Control account and authorizes the Director of Health to prescribe fees to help fund operations of the Department of Health in managing pollution from nonpoint sources and individual wastewater systems. Effective July 1, 2013. (HB903)
