<u>SB52</u> Status and Testimony	RELATING TO AGING. Establishes and funds a coordinator for active aging within the executive office on aging, which is to be appointed by the director.	HMS/HTH, WAM
<u>SB54</u> Status and Testimony	RELATING TO AGING. Allows the policy advisory board for elder affairs to grant members lifetime membership, which includes all the rights and privileges of a regular member, upon approval by all regular members of the board.	HMS/HTH
<u>SB358</u> <u>Status and Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires the department of health and the department of human services to post on their respective websites reports of all inspections in which a violation was discovered at certain care facilities by January 1, 2015.	HMS/HTH, WAM
<u>SB400</u> Status and Testimony	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Requires child care facilities, family child care homes, group child care centers, group child care homes, and infant and toddler child care centers that care for children one year of age or younger to develop, maintain, and implement safe sleep policies to prevent sudden unexpected infant deaths and sudden infant death syndrome. Makes certain requirements of operators.	HMS/HTH, CPN

RELATING TO HOUSING.

HMS/HTH, WAM

Appropriates unspecified funds to the homeless programs office of the department of human services and the rental housing trust fund. Appropriates unspecified funds to the department of health for substance abuse treatment, mental health support services, and clean and sober housing services, and to the department of human services for matching funds for shelter plus care grants. Appropriates funds for a rental assistance program, also known as a shallow subsidy program. Appropriates funds to the Hawaii public housing authority to continue to administer housing first programs for chronically homeless individuals and to reestablish the homeless prevention and rapid re-housing program. Appropriates funds out of the rental housing trust fund. Appropriates matching funds for the federal shelter plus care program to provide rental assistance in connection with supportive services.
