DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB517 RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING. HMS

Status and Testimony Permits clotheslines in state and federal public housing projects.

SB518 RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING. HMS, JDL

Status and Testimony Prohibits the Hawaii public housing authority from considering a prospective tenant's conviction for a minor crime that occurred five

years or more before the application date. Provides exceptions for crimes involving drugs, violence, sexual offenses, and alcohol.

SB1226 RELATING TO FAMILY COURT. HMS, JDL/WAM

Status and Testimony Clarifies the appointment requirements and qualifications for child

custody evaluators. Requires the courts to establish a complaint process. Reserves the appointment of a child custody evaluator for the conducting of an investigation and analysis of the best interest of the child regarding disputed custody and visitation issues in complex cases, where there is a possible risk to children, and that the court shall not order such an evaluation unless there is credible information regarding possible harm to the child or

impairment of parental duties.

SB1340 RELATING TO FOSTER CARE. HMS, WAM

Status and Testimony Allows former foster care youths who are attending an institution of

higher education as a full-time student, to stay in the foster care

system until the age of 23.
