SB 86 (SSCR749) <u>Status</u>

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

HSG, FIN

Moves the State income tax and obligations exemption for public housing agencies from the laws governing the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation to the laws governing the Hawaii public

housing authority.

SB 88, SD1 (SSCR540) RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN PUBLIC

HSG, JUD

HOUSING.

Status

Prohibits possessing or keeping, while on any sidewalk or common area within a public housing project, any bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any intoxicating liquor which has been opened, has a broken seal, or the contents of which have been partially removed. Adds "state low-income housing project" to definition of

public housing project for purposes of liquor control.

SB 84 (SSCR562) Status

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

HSG, FIN

Expands the scope of the definition of "public housing project" to include any housing project controlled or managed by the Hawaii public housing authority pursuant to federally assisted housing.
