SB 1220 RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS HTH, WAM

Status & CORPORATION.

Appropriates \$2,800,000 to the Hawaii health systems corporation to implement and sustain its primary care training

program at the Hilo medical center.

SB 1233 RELATING TO LEAVES OF ABSENCE. HTH, JDL

Requires certain private employers to allow employees to take paid leaves of absence for organ, bone marrow, or peripheral blood stem cell donation. Requires employers to restore an employee returning from leave to the same or equivalent

position. Establishes a private right of action for employees

seeking enforcement of provisions.

SB 1238 RELATING TO HEALTH. HTH

Establishes the maternal mortality review committee to conduct comprehensive reviews of maternal deaths in Hawaii, which includes collecting, analyzing, and disseminating maternal mortality information. Requires the committee to hold meetings and submit an annual report with findings and recommendations

to the legislature.

SB 1348 RELATING TO HEALTH. HTH, WAM

Requires the department of health to classify and recognize qualified hospitals and health care facilities that provide care to stroke patients. Allows hospitals and health care facilities to publicly advertise their recognition. Requires hospitals and health care facilities to report data to the department. Requires the department to create guidelines for pre-hospital stroke-triage assessment and maintain a statewide stroke database.

assessment and maintain a statewide stroke database. Requires the department to provide an annual report to the governor and legislature. Takes effect on 7/1/15.
