RELATING TO VETERINARY MEDICINE.

WTL/EGH. JDL

Prohibits the owner of a pet animal and the owner's employees from performing any surgical procedure, including but not limited to surgical birth, ear cropping, tail docking, dewclaw removal, and debarking on the pet animal without being licensed as a veterinarian. Makes intentionally or knowingly performing any surgical procedure, including but not limited to surgical birth, ear cropping, tail docking, dewclaw removal, and debarking, on a pet animal by any person not licensed as a veterinarian a class C felony. Specifies that accepted veterinary practices and cropping or docking as customarily practiced, shall not be considered cruelty to animals in the first degree if performed by a veterinarian

licensed under chapter 471, HRS. (SD1)

SB1026 (SSCR159) Status and Testimony RELATING TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION.

Provides the Land Use Commission with more efficient and varied methods of dealing with situations where a petitioner has violated

the conditions contained in a decision and order.
