HB 1481 Status

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

Exempts the offices of governor and lieutenant governor from the scope of the partial public financing law. Changes the law on qualifying contributions, voluntary expenditure limits, and maximum amount of available public funds for candidates for the office of state senator or state representative. Requires the campaign spending commission to submit a report on further statutory amendments to facilitate the implementation of this Act. Appropriates funds to the campaign spending commission to prepare for the partial public

financing of elections in 2014.

HB 632, HD1

(HSCR229)

Status

RELATING TO OPEN DATA.

Requires executive branch department to make electronic data sets available to the public. Absolves State for liability for deficiencies or incomplete data. Requires the Chief Information Officer to develop rules to implement the open data initiative. Effective July 1, 2013.
