HB 568 Status

RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION.

JUD

Specifies the duty of the elections commission to provide oversight of

the chief elections officer.

HB 90, HD1 (HSCR177) Status	RELATING TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE VEHICLES. Establishes a temporary Emergency Response Vehicle Noise Task Force to determine the impact of the emergency response vehicle sirens in terms of excessive noise, the effect on public safety, and the relative effectiveness of the use of emergency lights instead of the use of sirens at night. HB 740 (HSCR176) Status	RELATING TO OPEN CONTAINERS OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN PUBLIC HOUSING. Prohibits the possession or storage of an open container holding intoxicating liquor on any sidewalk or common area within any public housing project under the jurisdiction of the Hawaii public housing authority	HSG, JUD
HB 951 Status	RELATING TO THE SERVICE OF PROCESS. Update the statutes to authorize persons authorized by the courts to serve legal process.	JUD
<u>HB 791</u> (HSCR192) Status	RELATING TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS. Adds a new section to clearly provide that directors of a nonprofit corporation shall have access to the books and records of the corporation to the extent reasonably related to their duties.	CPC, JUD
