SB695 RELATING TO INDUSTRIAL HEMP RESEARCH. EGH/PSM, JDL

Status and Testimony Allows private funded industrial hemp research to be conducted

under certain conditions; requires monitoring by the DPS; requires reporting to the respective county law enforcement; exempts agronomic data derived from research from public records disclosure; confers immunity from criminal prosecution for the

research.
