HB1203 HD1 RELATING TO THE NATIONAL GUARD. PSM

(HSCR605) Provides preference for a person who has had at least five years

HB1381 HD2 (HSCR854) Status and Testimony RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSING.

PSM, CPN [Measure added on 3/14/2013]

Limits licensure by endorsement or reciprocity for nonresident military spouses to those spouses who are present in the State for at least one year pursuant to DOD orders. Limits consideration of military service or training for licensure by endorsement or reciprocity to veterans honorably discharged within two years of application and excludes medical doctors, dentists, CPAs, and other licensures for which specified endorsement or reciprocity regulations exist. Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1381 HD2)
