RELATING TO HAPUNA BEACH PARK.
Requires DLNR to enter into negotiations with the county of Hawaii for the lease of Hapuna Beach Park to the county. Requires DLNR to report to the legislature a lease agreement, or progress made if no agreement has been reached by 01/01/2014. Effective 07/01/2013. (SD2)

Status

RELATING TO COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT.
Adds a new section to part II of chapter 205A, HRS, to provide a process for state consistency review and certification for development by a state agency on state land within the special management area. After a notice of state consistency certification is published in the periodic bulletin by the office of environmental quality control, or upon issuance of federal consistency concurrence, a development by a state agency on state land shall be allowed within a special management area without obtaining a special management area permit or shoreline setback variance as otherwise required by chapter 205A, HRS. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD1)

<u>SB 1172</u> <u>(SSCR473)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE NATURAL AREA RESERVES SYSTEM COMMISSION. Amends the composition of the Natural Area Reserves System Commission by adding a member possessing a background in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, and removing the Superintendent of Education as a member. <u>SB 1371, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR584)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. Requires DLNR to accommodate mooring of native Hawaiian canoes owned by nonprofit entities and used for educational purposes in small boat harbors. Effective 07/01/50. (SD2)	WAL/OMH, FIN
<u>SB 456, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR824)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MAUNA KEA STATE RECREATIONAL AREA. Requires DLNR to enter into negotiations with the county of Hawaii for the lease of Mauna Kea state recreational area to the county. Requires DLNR to report to the legislature a lease agreement, or progress made if no agreement has been reached by 01/01/2014. Effective 07/01/2013. (SD2)	WAL, FIN
<u>SB 987, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR673)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO IMPACT FEES. Requires the assessment of impact fees prior to issuance of a water meter and requires that impact fees be collected in full before or upon issuance of the water meter. Effective 07/01/50. (SD1)	WAL, CPC
<u>SB 1002, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR676)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO KAPOLEI RECREATIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX. Makes housekeeping amendments to repeal the provisions providing for the maintenance, operation, management, and promotion of the Kapolei recreational sports complex from the Stadium Authority's statutory framework. (SD2)	WAL, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:
