RELATING TO WATER CONSERVATION. EEP, WAL SB 454, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1029) Encourages the widespread use of gray water in the interests of water Status conservation. Requires use of gray water to conform to the State Plumbing Code. Defines gray water. (SB454 HD1) RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRN, WAL SB 1207, HD1 (HSCR1146) Amends chapter 266, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to exempt the Department of Transportation, Harbors Division, from the permit and Status site plan approval requirements relating to submerged lands within the conservation district. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB1207 HD1)
