Proposed SD1 Status & Testimony RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Amends criteria to be used by the auditor in analyzing legislative bills proposing to establish new special or revolving funds. Clarifies that a special or revolving fund to be established or continued shall reflect a clear nexus between benefits sought and charges made upon program users or beneficiaries or between the program and the sources of revenue. Requires the auditor to review special funds, as well as revolving and trust funds, of designated governmental entities. Beginning 2014 and every five years thereafter, requires the auditor to review the special, revolving, and trust funds of the DOT and DOD. (Proposed SD1)
