in real property within the State subject to the conveyance tax.

Status and Testimony Reduces the tax liability for low-income people by creating a tax

credit that will reduce a person's income tax to zero if their federal adjusted gross income falls below federal poverty guidelines. Reduces a person's income tax liability by fifty per cent if the person's federal adjusted gross income falls between 100 and 125

percent of federal poverty guidelines.
