Tuesday, January 29, 2013

The Senate of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2013, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Kidani and Shimabukuro who were excused.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Sixth Day.

At this time, Senator Ihara introduced Karen Korematsu, daughter of civil rights hero and leader Fred Korematsu who passed away in 2005, and co-founder of the Fred T. Korematsu Institute for Civil Rights and Education.

Senator Ihara also introduced Rosanna Fukuda, a social studies education specialist from the Department of Education.

Senator Hee introduced, in both Hawaiian and English, Dr. Keiki Kawai'ae'a from the Ka Haka 'Ula O Ke'elikōlani College of Hawaiian Language, which was established by the Legislature at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo. Dr. Kawai'ae'a was visiting the Capitol as part of Pūnana Leo's 30th anniversary. Senator Hee also noted the presence of keiki singing in the rotunda as part of the Hawaiian Immersion Education Rally.
