Wednesday, March 13, 2013

The Senate of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2013, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Galuteria and Kim who were excused.

The Vice President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Ninth Day.
