Senator Chun Oakland and Committee Members:

My names is Anthony Lenzer. I am Chair of the Legislative Committee of the Policy Advisory Board for Elder Affairs (PABEA). Our Board strongly supports the nomination of Suzie Schulberg (GM 624) and Sarah Yuan (GM 625) to serve on PABEA, and urges the Senate to confirm these nominees.

Dr. Sarah Yuan Is a researcher at the Center on the Family at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. In this capacity, she has been responsible for developing a database on aging studies and reports, from both Hawaii and national sources. This database is extremely valuable to those of us concerned with developing public policy on aging, as it provides the factual basis for many of the policy proposals which are brought before the Legislature. Dr. Yuan has also been active in community organizations such as the Hawaii Pacific Gerontological Society, where she helped create the Society's highly successful 2012 biennial conference. Dr. Yuan's expertise should be a great asset to PABEA as it develops policy proposals in the future.

Suzie Schulberg is CEO of 15 Craigside, Hawaii's newest retirement and nursing care facility. In recent years, Hawaii has seen an impressive growth of retirement facilities, which play an important part in meeting the needs of many of Hawaii's older citizens who no longer wish to live in and maintain their own homes. 15 Craigside is a valuable community resource in that it also offers nursing home level care to those who are not residents of the facility as well as to Craigside residents. As you know, Hawaii's ratio of nursing home beds to population is well below the national average. Ms. Schulberg has also been active in community programs for older people, and is the immediate past president of the Hawaii Pacific Gerontological Society, which serves Hawaii's professionals in the field of aging.

PABEA requests that your Committee endorses these nominees, and recommend that the Senate confirm their appointment to our Board. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this matter.
