House Bill HB1264 HD2 RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LOANS

House Bill HB1264 HD2 expands the Department of Agriculture Agricultural Loan Program to provide loans for infrastructure, infrastructure improvements, the implementation of new farming techniques, and biosecurity projects.

The Taro Security and Purity Task Force is a legislative body, created in 2008 by Act 211 and 196, dedicated in part to encouraging through various means the economic viability of current and upcoming taro farmers in Hawai'i.
