Honolua Bay Management Plan Envisioned by the Save Honolua Coalition by Andrew O'Riordan

Context:

The Maui County Council has formulated and authored the Maui Island Plan that will shape growth and development on the island for the next ten years. Mayor Alan Arakawa has signed and approved this plan, which is now the official legal document that will regulate development over the next decade of Maui's growth.

As part of the kuleana of residents and government representatives, our generation is charged to plan and prepare for the future blossoming of Maui. The County Council plans for the medium term, typically covering the ten years between island plans. However, the broader discussion of how we hope Maui to evolve in the next twenty, fifty, one hundred, five hundred, one thousand years, and beyond, must inform the decisions our generation makes about near term development.

In the midst of the intricate legislative process involved in codifying the Maui Island Plan, a controversial issue rose again to the forefront of the public consciousness. Namely, what is to become of Honolua Bay, Lipoa Point, and the coastline that stretches beyond Lipoa through Windmills and up to Honokohau?

The issue arose when a motion was made in the County Council to put Lipoa Pt. into preservation, thus restricting its current owner, as well as any future owner, in how the land could be developed. By a vote of 6 to 3 votes, the County Council decided not to impose restrictions on how Lipoa Pt. could be developed, thus voting down the proposed preservation status, and in effect changing nothing.

The legal circumstances surrounding development on Lipoa Pt. are the same today as they were a year ago. The current landholder, Maui Land & Pineapple Inc., holds clear title to the land, which is currently zoned for agricultural development. In theory, as many as twenty luxury homes could be developed on Lipoa Pt.

Maui Land & Pineapple is facing increasing pressure from its creditors to put its financial house in order. Once a major power broker and a pillar of the West Maui economy, Maui Land & Pineapple has had to downsize its operations significantly in the face of competition from the Philippines, Central America, and other regions of the world where labor, fuel, and regulations make growing pineapples comparatively cheaper. The pace and scale of the diminishment of ML & P has been staggering, and the company is working deliberately to manage this transition responsibly.

ML & P continues to hold title to vast tracts of land, which are now its primary assets. This matters because ML & P is committed to honoring the pensions of over a

thousand former employees who earned their retirement and depend on their pensions to sustain their lives. In order to compensate former employees, ML & P has taken out loans and stretched its budget. The company is approaching a critical juncture when some of its debt obligations will mature, so it is actively seeking ways to generate more income. Among its options is the sale of Lipoa Pt. and the surrounding coastline for a value yet to be solidified, but expected to transact at around \$20-30 million.

Action Plan:

In recognition of all the worthy points mentioned in HB 1424, as well as the recent history that is placing increasing pressure on Lipoa Point, I urge the State of Hawaii deem the preservation of Lipoa Pt. a justifiable cause for intervention. This area is critical enough, relevant enough, and vital enough to merit the broader fiscal, psychological, and spiritual attention of the citizens of the state of Hawai'i. A bill that recognizes the pristine character of Lipoa Pt., and works to preserve that quality with financial and legal protection, is a bill that merits consideration by state lawmakers.

I understand that state needs far outweigh state resources, yet I urge lawmakers to deeply and fairly consider Hawaii's ethos, and to ensure that the life of the land be perpetuated in righteousness.

Cheesehead Says Yes on HB 1424

Dear members of the Hawaii House of Representatives,

I am from Wisconsin. Winters are trecherous. This morning it snowed seven inches, particularly wet and heavy. My mom called to say she was snowed-in. "Not an official snow day, but a snow day for us" she asserted. Instead, I'm on Maui. I first arrived last year with a videocamera and a mission to find what makes Hawaiians so healthy.

I found it.

Maui stays close to the land. It embraces and preserves its exceptional natural assets and native heritage. The local diet is rich with local fruits and greens. Gardens are built with native plants and maintained by school children. Archeologists are present as soon as shovels touch soul because history is so recent and rich. Beaches are publicly accessible everywhere. Surfing and canoeing are part of daily routine. Native language names the mountains and slack key is mastered on guitars handmade from koa. And above all, Maui residents deeply value preservation of all these things, shaping laws to share this unique value of the spirit of aloha. This isn't true in other states. That's what makes Maui so healthy.

When I saw Honolua Bay earlier this month, I was immediately struck. Minutes earlier I had taken a wrong turn off the highway, ended up in a carefully manicured resort caged in by nets, and tried desperately to accomplish a Y turn in a strip mall parking lot. Yet coming around the rugged curve of Honolua Bay was the start of the Maui I came to see. Starting at Lipoa Point, the western coast just has that unexplainable feeling of "real Maui". It makes you feel vulnerable and fragile and powerful at the same time. Just lucky to be on Maui of all places. Tennis courts and Sushi bars and coffeeshops can be found all over the mainland, including Wisconsin. But no where looks like Honoloa Bay. I don't pretend to know what is best for locals or speak with their voice, but I've met some of the kindest and smartest souls while on island. I hear their uproar for preservation, public access, and sustainable growth. They want you to also keep a core promise to protect the natural Maui lifestyle.

What I can absolutely attest to is that predatory tourism is an old idea. Places like Lipoa point are what visitors like me come for. For the power of the waves on the shore, the fragile reef, the joy of thriving marine life, the adventure of surfing. Not to be a force for flattening the land or interfering with the local way of life. If that was a conseuqnece of my presence, I would be heartbroken. With inevitable growth and tourism on Maui, setting precedents for sustainable tourism how is essential to the future. Preserving the rare and exotic bits like Honolua that make Maui special is worth the investment. This is what really attracts visitors, and what nourises those who live in the area.

If you want snow, you can visit Wisconsin (and please take some home with you). But if you want Honolua Bay, you can visit Maui. Hopefully for generations to come.

Thanks for all you do to preserve Maui's connection to its land, and for voting YES on HB 1424 for the health of the ecosystem, the health of its inhabitants, the health of a sustainable tourist industry, and the health of the commitment to protect what Maui has to teach the world.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of this important measure. The purpose of this measure is to appropriate general obligation bonds for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, in consultation with the Hawaiian Islands Land Trust, to engage in efforts to acquire the parcel of land located at Lipoa Point.

The Maui Council has not had the opportunity to take a formal position on this measure. Therefore, I am providing this testimony in my capacity as an individual member of the Maui County Council.

I support this measure for the following reasons:

- 1. By Ordinance 4004 (2012), the Maui Island Plan was adopted as part of the Maui County General Plan. The Maui Island Plan establishes, for the first time, urban and rural growth boundaries on the island of Maui. The Maui Island Plan also identifies areas that should be permanently protected because of their significant environmental, ecological, cultural, and recreational value, and because degradation of the resource would result in an irretrievable loss. During its deliberations on the Maui Island Plan, the Council heard from hundreds of testifiers pleading with the Council to identify Lipoa Point for permanent protection. Unfortunately, the Council was only comfortable identifying the immediate coastal areas of Lipoa Point and Honolua Bay for protection because these lands are already in the State Conservation District. The Council did not want to identify the other lands at Lipoa Point and Honolua Bay for permanent protection because of the potential devastating consequences of more than 1,600 retirees of Maui Land & Pine whose pensions may be jeopardized by the potential devaluation of the property.
- 2. Due to economic conditions, Maui Land & Pine stopped pineapple operations in 2009 and was forced to lay off workers. Because of the reduction in active employee participation in the pension plan, the company posted approximately 1,400 acres in West Maui as collateral in April 2011. The land remains collateralized today. When the

company ended its golf operations in March 2011, the loss of additional active employees participating in the pension plan triggered the requirement of additional security. Maui Land & Pine is relying on Lipoa Point and over 5,300 acres mauka of Honolua to secure the additional unfunded retirement liability.

3. Since 2007, the Mayor and Council have consistently pledged \$1 million for the acquisition of land at Lipoa Point, but we cannot do it alone. We need partners from the State and Federal Government, and from concerned community groups to ensure the preservation of Lipoa Point in perpetuity.

For the foregoing reasons, I support this measure.

In consideration of HOUSE BILL 1424 RELATING TO THE ACQUISTION OF RESOURCE VALUE LAND

The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) appreciates the intent of House Bill 1424, which proposes to require the Department, in consultation with the Hawaiian Islands Land Trust (HILT) and notwithstanding Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) approval, to engage in efforts to acquire the parcel of land located at Lipoa Point, identified as tax map key 2-4-1-001-010-0000. The bill also proposes an appropriation to fully or partly fund the acquisition.

In brief discussions with HILT, the Department has learned that the owner, Maui Land and Pineapple Company, Inc., is a willing seller and that HILT is hiring an appraiser to provide a letter of appraisal and eventually a full appraisal of the subject property and intends to apply for State grant-in-aid to fund the due diligence process. Notwithstanding the Board's approval under Section 173A-5(i), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), the Department is able to continue discussions with HILT regarding the acquisition of the subject property pursuant to the regular due diligence procedures of the Department and approval of the Board required under Section 171-30, HRS. The Department supports acquisition provided that the designated management program has the capacity to manage the property for its cultural and recreational values.

The Department presently provides funding to Maui Land and Pineapple Company, Inc., for conservation and restoration actions in its mauka watershed forests through grant agreements from the Natural Area Partnership Program and the Forest Stewardship Program.

Comments: My Name is John Carty and I live on Maui in the moku of Ka'anapali and Honolua ahupua'a. I'm the v.p. of the Save Honolua Coalition and I speak on behalf of our organization. We support HB 1424. We are working together with the land owner, Maui Land & Pineapple, Hawaiian Islands Land Trust, and Aha Moku representatives from our moku. I come to you with a sense of urgency. Many factors are coming together to make now our best chance to Save Honolua and create a win-win situation for all involved. The unstable financial condition of the land owner, Maui Land & Pineapple Company looms over the open space of Honolua like a dark cloud. About 5 1/2 years ago MLP withdrew plans for development at Honolua after overwhelming testimony from the community including over 19,000 physical signatures to the Save Honolua petition calling for the preservation and acquisition of this area. Since then, we have been exploring different ways to preserve the land while taking steps towards cleanup and revitalization with the land owner and various groups. There are many reasons why it is crucial to Save Honolua with a land trust. And while it is enough to do it for her own sake because she is Honolua, I will mention more. First: Revenue. Honolua is what tourists love and it is the star attraction in West Maui where the majority of high end luxury hotels on Maui are are. Its snorkeling, open space, and wild beauty are the essence of what brings the tourists along with their money to our State. During the summer and other peak days, our studies conclude that over 1000 people access Honolua Bay by land and sea. Second: The environment. Honolua Bay is a State Marine Life Concervation District and the reef is dying fast. The must recent DLNR survey reveals that there used to be 45% coral cover in the Bay in 1995 and 10 years later is was less than 9%. That was over 7 years ago. After the latest development in our Ahupua'a several years ago, events like this started happening (show picture of mud flow). This runoff has been devastating. We must make certain that this does not happen again. Third: The community. Honolua is beloved by the people of Maui for reasons too many to mention. Surfing is a big one. It is known as "The Bay" and loved world wide by surfers for its perfect shape. Our West Maui shoreline is filled with Hotels, Restaurants, and private homes from Pua'mana all the way to Kapalua. Honolua is the first open space and the playground and sanctuary for our people. And fourth, the most important reason, is the culture. The harm done to our host culture and its people by development and western

land practices is unimaginable. We can, through this bill, Save this area so that future generations of Hawaiians can connect to this sacred land of their ancestors. In 1976 the Hokulea launched from Honolua on her maiden voyage. There are many important cultural sites in the area including heiau, burials, holua slide, kings trail, and more. I am lucky to be friends with a few kupuna from the area and I wish they could be here today to tell you the deep spirituality and sacredness of honolua. And maybe they would tell you what they have told me... "We are counting on you to save it." So please support HB 1424 and help the Save Honolua Coalition, Maui Land & Pineapple, Hawaiian Islands Land Trust, and the people of Maui to Save Honolua Forever. Mahalo.

Comments: Aloha Committee Members, I respectfully submit my support and comments on the House Bill # 1424 - relating to the acquisition of resource value lands. Honolua is an icon, not only in Hawai'i but across the globe, for its unique ecosystems, its local charm and its world-class waves. It is unfortunate that it has taken this long to consider protection of Honolua and Lipoa Point and our organization is in support of the current proposal to save this area. Hawai'i's coral reef communities, including Honolua, have tremendous importance because they provide protection from storm waves, create the world famous large Hawaiian surf waves, provide a marine nursery for the surrounding region and are critical to the State's marine tourism industry worth approximately \$800 million per year (Friedlander et al., 2005). Further loss of these coastal resources and reef species would be a massive blow to the local ecosystems, the propagation of nearby island reefs and to the local communities that utilize this protected area. It is possible to reverse the trend of decline; however studies in similar coastal ecosystems in Hawaii have found that it may take as long as 50 years for reefs to reach full recovery (Chaston and Oberding, 2007) and so timing is crucial to begin the long process of healing. The evidence that sediment is the main cause of coral decline in the Honolua/Mokulei'a Marine Life Conservation District (MLCD) is strongly supported and it has become our opportunity to address this issue. The Hawaii Division of Aquatic Resources (DAR) with CRAMP has found that coral cover in Honolua has declined from 42% in 1995 to only 8% in 2009 (State of Hawaii, 2008 – updated in 2009 graph). This data shows a steady decrease in coral cover during 1994 – 1999, stabilization from 2000 – 2004 (a documented drier period), and a decrease again in 2005 - 2009 (State of Hawaii, 2008). Another source, Dollar and Grigg (2004) recorded a similar decline in coral cover of nearly 33% from 1992 to 2002. Cycles of damage and recovery are evident due to repeated sedimentation events, poor flushing and restrictive currents of the inner Honolua Bay which prolong the trapping and deposition of sediment (Hawaii LAS, 2004). US Geological Service studies have shown that degradation to West Maui reefs will also affect reefs on the nearby island of Lana'i, as many of the coral larvae for that island come from the West Maui reefs (U.S Army Corp of Engineers, 2010). The CRAMP surveys also found Montipora sp., Pocillopora sp. and Porites sp. to be the dominant corals during their surveys from 1994 to 2006 (Chaston and Oberding, 2007), some

of these which are being proposed for listing as a U.S. Threatened Species under the Endangered Species Act. Despite a severe decline in coral health, many of our charismatic mega-fauna are frequently seen in and around the waters of Honolua Bay. "Fish survey data collected by the CRAMP from 1998 showed that among 60 reefs, their survey site on the north reef at Honolua North ranked 3 in species richness,49 in density, 30 in biomass, and 3 in diversity" (Chaston and Oberding, 2007). Many varieties of cetaceans (dolphins and whales) are known to frequent the area spinner dolphin groups, bottlenose dolphin groups, pan tropical spotted dolphin groups, false killer whales and even pygmy killer whales. It is well known locally that cetacean species often travel between sites on Lana'i Island and Honolua Bay to enjoy clearer conditions during murky events at one of the locations. Large congregations of the threatened Green Sea Turtle are also regularly found at a "cleaning station" in the center of Honolua Bay. Protecting Honolua Bay and Lipoa Point will allow for future conservation efforts to focus on this area, instead of relying on development to take care of Pensioners of the landowner's company. I believe that this bill supports a thoughtful use of the land and protects it from future development, thereby allowing land use changes to be implemented that will slow the decline of coral health and prevent further degradation from over-use and sedimentation. Aloha Chair Hanohano, Chair Evans and members of the Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources and Hawaiian Affairs and members of the Committee on Water and Land,

My name is Dr. Scott Fisher and I am the Director of Conservation for the Hawaiian Islands Land Trust. I am here today to ask you to support House Bill 1424 which would provide General Obligation Bond funding to purchase Honolua Bay and Lipoa Point.

Honolua Bay is an incredibly rich and culturally important area, with numerous archaeological sites dating back hundreds of years. As the site where the voyaging canoe Hokule'a left for Tahiti, Honolua tells the story of the Hawaiian people, representing both the connection to our land, and the struggle to protect and preserve the wisdom which the kupuna handed down to us through the generations.

In addition to the rich cultural history of this area, preserving this site will also ensure greater protection through active stewardship of the sensitive ecosystems of Honolua and the adjacent ocean. These include the Honolua Marine Reserve and the four miles of coastline stretching between Honokohau and Honolua. Although decades of commercial agriculture have dramatically altered the environment, we are very confident that through thoughtful and sustained stewardship this coastline will support numerous native species, including threatened and endangered flora and fauna. A refuge which would protect Honolua and Lipoa Point in perpetuity could also serve as a model for future sustainability on Maui, and we would particularly welcome the restoration of traditional farming practices, such as lo'i kalo.

The Hawaiian Islands Land Trust is working collaboratively with a number of groups and organizations to ensure that the voice of the community is heard in this process and that the vision and values of our partners, such as the Save Honolua Coalition come to fruition. The work of the Save Honolua Coalition has been invaluable in providing a forum for the community to be heard and we anticipate working very closely with them, and other stakeholders to bring this vision into a reality which benefits everyone who knows and loves Honolua.

Your support of this bill is a critical step in advancing the protection of Honolua, a move which will have immense conservation value, not only for the people of Maui, but all of the people of Hawai'i as well as the many visitors who come to Maui.

My name is Tamara Paltin, I am the President of a 501c3 non-profit, Save Honolua Coalition. Our organization is in full support of HB1454, Honolua Bay and the area commonly referred to as Lipoa point but traditionally known as Kulaokaea holds tremendous resource value for the state of Hawaii. The value is in the open spaces and public access which would be lost if this area was allowed to be developed.

Our community has been speaking out to maintain open space at Kulaokaea for many years and there is now a rare opportunity with a landowner willing to sell this valuable parcel, a successful land trust willing to take on the land and all proceeds being dedicated to unfunded pensioner liabilities - ILWU, etc.

This bill will allow us to save an area that has so much meaning and has yet to be tainted by private, commercial development. Future generations can learn that Honolua is one of the famous bays of Piilani (Na Honoapiilani) and it is still in a natural state. It has a literal meaning of the "two bays" and a kaona meaning of the "fighting bay" the next bay North Honokohau was documented to be a major food source in the area and Honolua may have been the area where our ancestors stood to protect those resources, the area where we stand today to protect our natural resources from development. Once the area is developed it will never be the same and this bay is so unique because it is the most sheltered from prevailing trade winds making it ideal for all manner of aquatic activities, which would be threatened if development were allowed to occur.

In the seventies, the former major landowner of the area realized what a special place Honolua is and with the help of the community created the Honolua Bay – Mokuleia marine life conservation district. However, no protection was given to mauka lands and so because of development and past harmful agricultural practices the ecosystem of this area has been in decline. Even though the area is not as pristine as it was decades ago it is still beloved by many and if the community is given the opportunity to take care of this parcel with the guidance of the aha moku council it could become a model for the future of land conservation with respect to culture in Hawaii.

Honolua Bay is also a major revenue source for our state regardless of season or weather hundreds if not thousands of visitors come to experience the beauty that is Honolua; a beauty that we hope to perpetuate and continue to share.

Honorable chair and committee members,

I would like to submit testimony in support of H.B. 1424 involving dedicating funds to the acquisition of Lipoa Point, located in West Maui. For several years I lived and worked in agriculture in West Maui and am personally familiar with the challenges this area has faced in terms of sedimentation and other pollutants making their way into the bay. The coral reefs have visibly declined in percent coral cover, a fact that has been confirmed by the CRAMP monitoring carried out by DLNR DAR. In the past year, I have begun working in watershed health issues in the area, and have become even more aware of the threats facing the health of this precious ecosystem. Despite the reduction in agricultural activity in the area, the health of the marine environment continues to suffer. We would do well to remember that while coral only covers 0.5% of the ocean, it houses 25% of marine life, so allowing coral reef collapse leads to multi-species collapse.

Securing this land for preservation is one of the few actions that can be taken to help buffer this area from further degradation. This is one of the few special areas in Maui that has a high level of grassroots support for stewardship, but the financial burden of bearing this solely through volunteerism is not a long term solution. Acquiring this land would remove the threat of development, and make the way for the creation to a management plan.

Thank you for your consideration of support for this bill- maintaining the health of an ecosystem is much more cost effective than attempts to restore it following collapse, and acquiring Lipoa Point creates the opportunity to do just that.
