### TESTIMONY ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2107, H.D. 1 - RELATING TO INSURANCE.

TO THE HONORABLE SYLVIA LUKE, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is Gordon Ito, State Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), testifying on behalf of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Department"). The Department supports the intent of the bill, and submits the following additional comments:

This bill requires the auditor to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of establishing a State of Hawaii captive insurance company to insure all or a portion of the State's property and casualty risk.

The Department appreciates that the bill has been amended to include language ensuring that the expert selected to conduct the study will possess considerable knowledge and experience in forming and developing captive programs. Especially considering the Auditor's estimate of \$300,000 to complete the study, we respectfully recommend that the final report include an objective comparison between options presented in a coherent format that includes their respective benefits and shortcomings, and the expert's findings, conclusions, and recommendation.

We thank the Committee for the opportunity to present testimony on this matter.
