In consideration of HOUSE BILL 2552, HOUSE DRAFT 1 RELATING TO OCEAN RESOURCES

House Bill 2552, House Draft 1 proposes to direct the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to conduct a study of Pohoiki Bay in order to resolve the conflicts among the users of the Bay requires the Department to establish a Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement (DOCARE) position for the Pohoiki Bay area to be funded through geothermal royalties. **The Department offers the following comments.**

The Department does not feel that a study would be needed because the Department currently has the authority to manage the area. The Department can commit to scheduling a meeting with the various user groups of the area to hear their concerns regarding Native Hawaiian gathering and subsistence rights, recreational users, commercial boat tours and fishers to determine whether additional regulations are needed or not.

The Department appreciates the Legislature's willingness to support DOCARE by establishing a new position for the Pohoiki Bay area but feels that since DOCARE is charged with a wide geographical coverage limiting an officer to one spot is unfair to other areas and inefficient.

RELATING TO OCEAN RESOURCES

House Bill No. 2552, H.D. 1, requires the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) to conduct a study of Pohoiki Bay in order to resolve the conflicts among the users of the Bay. The bill further allows DLNR to expend "so much of the royalties it receives from geothermal resource mining leases as is necessary" to establish and maintain a conservation enforcement officer position in the Division of Conservation and Resource Enforcement for the Pohoiki Bay area.

While the Department of Budget and Finance does not take any position on the requirement to conduct the study of the Pohoiki Bay area, the department notes that an appropriation of "so much of the royalties it receives from the geothermal resource mining lease as is necessary" is not a valid appropriation.
