## HB 2598 - Relating to Hawaii 3R's

We support this measure to facilitate the administrative transfer of taxpayer contributions from the state DOE to Hawaii 3R's. Those taxpayer contributions will be put to work on behalf of the state DOE in addressing its repair and maintenance backlog at Hawaii's public schools.

Hawaii 3R's works closely with the state DOE to ensure that all projects meet the standards of the DOE and at completion, are accepted by the DOE. You will find few, if any, state projects where volunteers work alongside of professional contractors to complete R&M projects in Hawaii's public schools.

Over the past 13 years, Hawaii 3R's has achieved a credible and effective track record that has helped the organization to both meet its mission and help the state DOE with the repair and maintenance backlog:

- Since 2001, Hawaii 3R's has helped the state to realize a savings of over \$43.0 million.
- With every state dollar invested in Hawaii 3R's, \$12.00 of work has been completed.
- The estimated value of completed projects (by Hawaii 3R's) over the past decade is over \$46.5 million.

Renames the Hawaii 3R's school repair and maintenance fund the Hawaii 3R's school improvement fund. Requires the transfer of moneys collected pursuant to section 235-102.5(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, and any other moneys received in the form of grants and donations for school-level improvements and minor repairs and maintenance to the

Hawaii 3R's school improvement fund.
