In consideration of HOUSE BILL 359 RELATING TO OCEAN RESOURCES

House Bill 359 proposes to authorize administrative inspections of commercial fishers and wholesalers within the West Hawaii regional fishery management area. <u>The Department of Land</u> and Natural Resources ("Department") offers the following comments.

The Department currently inspects commercial fishers and wholesalers under Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) §187A-15 and §189-14. These statutes apply statewide, not just in West Hawaii.

The term "administrative inspections" is not clear. When does it apply? How does this differ from the existing authority? The Department notes the elimination of the "probable cause" requirement. This may present constitutional problem, certainly for criminal prosecutions.

Finally, the Department would like to address a general issue in natural resources enforcement that needs more attention. In an effort to ensure compliance with both statutes and administrative rules, many people focus on tougher criminal penalties. But the practical reality is that administrative enforcement is easier, quicker, and more effective than law suits. And administrative enforcement is far more effective, less time consuming, and far less expensive than cumbersome criminal prosecution. This is not to say that, sometimes, bad actors that must be pursued under the criminal laws.

Administrative actions give the Department an opportunity to educate and change behavior across a broad community spectrum. Since the ultimate purpose of administrative rules is to modify social behavior over the long term, not to collect fines, the opportunity to interact with the fishing community on a more informal basis is important.

By contrast, law suits require a state attorney general (or a *county* prosecutor) to file civil (or criminal) actions in court. Invariably, they get tied up in the court's process and schedule. Often, the State's attorney or the county prosecutor are not familiar with complex natural resources management issues or have higher priority cases. If they do get to trial, then he or she must convince a circuit court judge (who may have no background in natural resources management) that this case is worth serious attention and that the penalties are important in a larger management program. Many view fishing violations as incidental slaps on the wrist.

In a criminal case, the prosecutor has the highest burden of proof ("beyond a reasonable doubt" v. "reliable, probative, and substantial evidence") and the county prosecutor must present witnesses (often state Department enforcement officers) with whom the prosecutor has little or no regular professional contact (or even time). The obstacles of convincing a county prosecutor to pursue a criminal action in circuit court with a judge facing a crowded felony calendar and state witnesses (who seldom appear in court) are often overwhelming.

The Department can address administratively the same remedies quicker, more effectively, and with a greater chance of success.

This is a recipe for disaster.

You can't just dole out this kind of responsibility "willy nilly". DOCARE officers are specially trained to do their work, and to think or expect untrained and unqualified "agents" to do this job correctly, and with the proposed "no probable cause" amendment as well, is ridiculous. Trained DOCARE professionals are challenged enough, with probable cause, to do their jobs fairly.

Leave this work to the professionals. Leave this job with DOCARE.

I also take issue with the fabrication of a problem where a problem doesn't exist. Your rationale and justification for this bill are unfounded. The present inspection process is quite adequate and while it could arguably use a few more inspectors to improve on it, anything more is simply superfluous and unnecessary.

If you want to try and trample all over my constitutional rights by trying to eliminate probable cause from the inspection process, be my guest and good luck to you. "Probable cause" has been a long-standing constitutional protection shared by all Americans; one that separates us from all the countries in the world we despise for their lack of civil rights.

Last I looked, one of the cornerstones that makes our judicial system a world gold standard is that we are all innocent until proven guilty.

We are not China or Russia or any one of a dozen Arab countries.

I'm sorry but you need probable cause.
