- 1 **Department's Position:** We support this bill provided that its passage does not replace or adversely
- 2 impact priorities indicated in our Executive Budget.
- 3 Fiscal Implications: Appropriates 1.5 million dollars in FY2014 and FY2015 for pre-hospital

4 emergency medical services 24 hours a day at Ewa Beach on Oahu.

- 5 Purpose and Justification: The Department of Health supported Act 268 of the 2012 Legislature
- 6 appropriating one million dollars for a new ambulance unit in Ewa Beach, Oahu. The new unit was
- 7 needed to mitigate the closure of Hawaii Medical Center West, and also to serve the growing population
- 8 of Ewa and West Oahu. A new Ewa unit was opened this past summer operating out of a temporary
- 9 location in Ewa for 16 hours a day. The need for this additional unit in West Oahu is unchanged and
- 10 therefore we recommend it become a permanent unit with appropriate funding.
