Testimony:

Case Management Professionals, Inc. supports HB 398 with the following amendments:

- 1. Allow creation of a task force to perform the following duties
 - a. oversee the transition of community based services under the Department of Human Services (DHS) which are being transferred to the Department of Health (DOH) effective July 1, 2014.
 - b. Provide recommendations to the legislature on the transition no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 2014 Legislature.
- 2. The task force shall include the ff: representation:
 - a. one (1) member of senate appointed by the Senate President;
 - b. one (1) member of the house of representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
 - c. one (1) representative from the Department of Human Services (DHS)
 - d. one (1) representative from the Department of Health (DOH)
 - e. four (4) licensed case management agencies (CMA)
 - f. four (4) community care foster family homes (CCFFH)
 - g. four (4) adult residential care homes (ARCH) which includes expanded residential care homes (E-ARCH)
- 3. Member of the task force shall serve without compensation upon approval of the legislature and shall cease to exist on June 30, 2014.

Statements:

Providing quality and safe care in residential facilities require service integration of a qualified caregiver and a case management agency for the ff: reasons.

- 1. Clients are fragile, aged, disabled, medically-complexed and are at a nursing home level of care who requires professional oversight.
- 2. Complex care is provided in an alternative and improvised residential home setting.
- Care providers are unlicensed assistive personnel and may only perform required skilled nursing tasks like oral medication administration, insulin injections, tube feedings, oxygen administration, foley care, and other nursing task under the delegation of a registered nurse case manager.
- 4. Caregivers are unable to provide care and service assessments, service plan development, coordination and monitoring.
- Case management agencies provides a team of RN/LSW and ancillary personnel to provide a holistic and comprehensive case management services required for a home setting which includes required psychosocial, financial, health, functional, environmental assessments, conflict resolutions and crisis intervention.
- 6. Case management agencies are licensed and monitored by the state and subject to annual audits by the HMO's with stringent licensing, operational and compliance requirements..

Case management agencies shall be a significant asset to the task force because of its expertise not only in professional nursing and human services but also in regulatory, operational, legislative, programs, community, healthcare resources and dynamics of both the community care foster family homes and the expanded-care homes.

We are confident that the Consumer Protection Committee shall be able to assure consumer awareness and public safety by careful review not only of the significance of case manager's role in the task force but also in community and home based care.
